Narration: Planning ahead is a key element to traveling abroad. Don't pack your bags just yet. You will need ensure your documents are in order and in hand before you travel abroad. Obtaining a US passport can take up to 12 weeks for processing however you may pay extra to expedite the process. Even expediting could take up to 6 weeks. If you already have a passport - It must have at least two months left before its expiration remaining.

With lots of options to choose from, taking a train will get you where you want to go. Outside of commuter trains, taking a train between cities is a two step process. First you need to purchase a ticket, then you need a reservation for a particular route and time. These two steps can be done at the same time, or you can choose to purchase a round trip ticket and make the return reservation at a later date. Taking a train can be a comfortable way to see the countryside, and you can eat a meal while seeing the sights. This is a more expensive way to travel however, so those comforts come at a price.
